1. Overview

This page outlines the Terms of Use, Privacy Policy, Data Processing Addendum (DPA), Confidentiality (NDA), and Security Framework governing access to the OneVue Invoice Demo Environment (“Demo Service”) provided by Ecovue Solutions (“Provider”).

The Demo Service is intended solely for evaluation and demonstration purposes and is not a production-grade SaaS offering.

By accessing or using the Demo Service, you (“Customer”) agree to the terms outlined below.

2. Terms of Use (Demo Agreement)

2.1 Purpose of the Demo

- The Demo Service is provided strictly for evaluation and demonstration
 - It is not intended for production or business-critical use
 - No service-level guarantees (SLA) apply
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2.2 Scope of Capabilities

The Demo Service may include:

- Invoice ingestion (email, upload, API)
 - AI-based data extraction
 - Workflow, validation, and approvals
 - Dashboards and reporting
 - AI-powered query assistant
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2.3 Customer Responsibilities

The Customer agrees to:

- Use the system only for evaluation purposes

- Attempt to reverse engineer the platform
 - Use the system for unlawful purposes
 - Interfere with system integrity or security

- The Demo is provided “as-is” and “as-available”
 - Ecovue may:
 - Modify features
 - Reset environments
 - Delete data without notice
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2.6 Intellectual Property

All rights to:

- OneVue Invoice platform
- AI models and algorithms
- Documentation and UI

remain the exclusive property of Ecovue Solutions.

2.7 Limitation of Liability

Ecovue Solutions shall not be liable for:

- Data loss or corruption
 - Business interruption
 - Errors in AI extraction or workflow
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2.8 Termination

Access may be:

- Limited to a defined evaluation period
 - Terminated at any time without notice
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3. Privacy Policy

3.1 Data Collected

The Demo Service may process:

- Invoice documents (PDF, images, emails)
 - Extracted data (vendor, amounts, tax, dates)
 - User activity and system logs
 - Usage analytics
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3.2 Purpose of Data Processing

Data is used to:

- Demonstrate invoice automation capabilities
 - Extract and validate invoice data
 - Provide dashboards and analytics
 - Improve AI models and system performance
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3.3 Data Storage

- Data is hosted on Oracle Cloud Infrastructure (OCI) or agreed environment
 - Storage is temporary and for demo use only
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3.4 Data Retention

- Data may be deleted:
 - Periodically
 - At end of demo
 - Upon request

No long-term retention is guaranteed.

3.5 Data Sharing

Data is not sold or shared except:

- With infrastructure providers (e.g., OCI)
 - When required by law
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3.6 User Rights

Customers may:

- Request access to their data
- Request deletion of demo data

4. Data Processing Addendum (DPA)

4.1 Roles

- Customer = Data Controller
 - Ecovue Solutions = Data Processor
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4.2 Processing Scope

Ecovue processes data solely to:

- **Provide demo functionality**
 - **Improve system performance**
 - **Support evaluation use cases**
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4.3 Sub-processors

Ecovue may use:

- Oracle Cloud Infrastructure (OCI)
- AI/LLM service providers (where applicable)

All sub-processors adhere to industry-standard security practices.

4.4 Data Protection Measures

- Encryption (in transit and/or at rest where applicable)
- Role-based access control
- Secure API communication

- Monitoring and logging
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4.5 Cross-Border Transfers

Data may be processed in global cloud regions depending on OCI deployment.

4.6 Data Breach Handling

In case of a data breach (where applicable), Ecovue will:

- Investigate promptly
 - Notify affected parties as required by applicable laws

6.1 Infrastructure

OneVue Invoice Demo runs on:

- Oracle Cloud Infrastructure (OCI)
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6.2 Security Framework

The platform leverages OCI capabilities including:

- Identity and Access Management (IAM)
 - Secure Object Storage
 - Oracle Database 23ai
 - API Gateway and secure endpoints
 - Container-based deployment
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6.3 Security Controls

- Role-based access control
 - Secure authentication
 - Network isolation (where applicable)
 - Logging and monitoring
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6.4 Scalability & Performance

- Containerized architecture for scalability
 - High-volume document processing capability
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6.5 Compliance Approach

While the demo environment may not be fully production-certified:

- It follows enterprise-grade architecture principles
 - Can be deployed in secure, compliant environments for production use
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7. AI & Data Usage Transparency

- AI models are used for:
 - Data extraction
 - Classification
 - Validation assistance
 - AI may improve over time using:
 - Patterns (not identifiable personal profiling)
 - Human validation workflows remain available
